NOTICE OF RACE

Organising Authority

The event will be organised by Loch Lomond Sailing Club in association with the International Moth Class UK.

Rules

Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, *The RYA Prescriptions*, and *The International Moth Class Rules*. Section 3 'Rules of Navigation' of the *Loch Lomond Byelaws 2013* apply when meeting boats that are not racing. This changes the Part 2 preamble. Competitors can view a copy of the Loch Lomond Byelaws 2013 in the Race Office and at the website www.lochlomond-trossachs.org.

Eligibility

The event is open to all boats of the International Moth Class that meet the requirements of the Class Rules. All competing helms shall be members of IMCA UK or in the case of overseas competitors they shall be members of their local Moth Class Association or IMCA. Helms from Scottish clubs will be eligible for the Scottish Championship. Membership Cards and Measurement Certificates may be required to be produced at Registration. Each participating boat must be insured with valid third party insurance with a minimum cover of £3 million.

Entries

The Entry Form on page 3 of this Notice of Race must be completed and signed by all competitors. Cost of Entry for visitors will be £30 per boat. Advance entries may be sent to Peter McLaren, 28 Laurelhill Gardens, Stirling, FK8 2PT (cheques payable to Loch Lomond Sailing Club) or e-mail petermclaren@talktalk.net (pay at Registration). **Entries postmarked not later than Saturday 28 September will have a £5 discount, i.e. entry fee of £25 per boat.** LLSC members' boats £10 (early & late entry).

The Parent/Guardian Declaration on Page 2 of Entry Form, must be completed and signed for competitors under the age of 16.

Registration

Competitors may register in the clubhouse from 11am on Friday 4 October and from 10am on Saturday 5 October. Sailing Instructions, evening meal tickets and Camping Permits (£10 per night per campervan, £5 per night per tent) will be available at Registration.

Racing Programme

Racing will be on Loch Lomond off the club grounds. The course for Friday's long distance (non-championship) race will be set around islands and fixed marks on Loch Lomond, and will be set on the day. Courses on Saturday and Sunday will be windward/leeward. 8 races are scheduled for the Inland and Scottish Championships (1 discard if 4 or more races are held) and 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a Championship.

Flying Fifteen and Keelboats will be holding Open meetings on Saturday 5 and Sunday 6. They will start before the International Moths and will sail courses around islands and fixed marks away from the Moth sailing area.

Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

Scoring

The long distance race will not form part of the Inland or Scottish Championships. Scoring for the Inland and Scottish Championships will be i.a.w. RRS Appendix A.

Prizes

Prizes will be at the discretion of the race committee having regard to the number of boats entered but will include UK Inland Champion, Scottish Champion and Long Distance Race Winner.

Disclaimer of Liability:

Risk Statement: Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone." Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in an event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- (d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- (f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
